Mission

Create an organized framework for the purpose of building strong relationships between the Latino Community and King's College and to assist in addressing the needs of Latino community families.

Misión

Programs for adults

ESL classes are offered three times a week during the semester for those LLP (limited language proficiency) adults.

Computer classes in Spanish are offered in cycles of eight sessions. The objective of the class is to provide basic computer skills to the Latino community such as basic hardware and word processing skills, as well as to increase the English proficiency of students with limited literacy.

General Education Diploma (GED) Prep classes in Spanish are offered for those adults who want to get the GED Diploma. These classes help people to prepare themselves to take the GED Test in Spanish.

Programas para adultos

Se ofrecen clases de ingles, tres veces a la semana, para adultos con un limitado nivel de ingles o con algún conocimiento de ingles.

Se ofrecen clases de computación en español en ciclos de ocho sesiones. El objetivo de la clases es enseñar a la comunidad Latina las habilidades básicas de la computación. Tales como Microsoft Word y Hardware. Así como también mejorar las habilidades comunicativas de los estudiantes con un nivel limitado de ingles.

Las clases de GED en español se ofrecen para los adultos que quieren obtener el Diploma del GED. Estas clases les ayuda a prepararse para tomar el examen de GED en **ESPAÑOL**.
